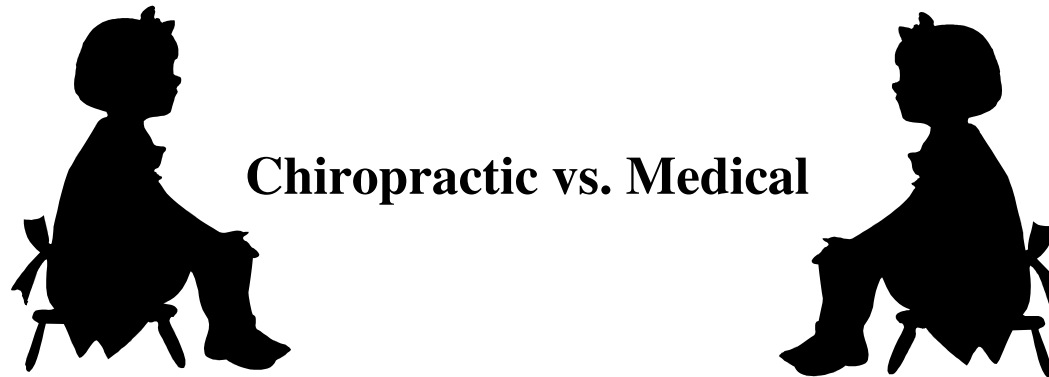


# A COMPARATIVE STUDY OF CHILDREN'S HEALTH IN CHIROPRACTIC VS. MEDICAL HOUSEHOLDS



In a random survey, 200 pediatricians and 200 chiropractors were selected and surveyed to determine what, if any, differences were between the health of the doctors' children raised under different healthcare models.

Survey analysis revealed that the chiropractic children had fewer ear infections compared to the medical children (20% vs. 69%), fewer allergies, less tonsillitis, less antibiotic therapy and less medication overall.
